
National Convenors and Treasurer's 2021 reports

Emma and Malina provided verbal summaries of their reports and these were also displayed onscreen for those who had not read the email attachments sent out previously.


Acceptance of these two reports were moved as a single motion by Emma Timewell, seconded by Nicolette Rattenbury and unanimously passed by attendees.
